ORDER :-

In pursuance of the provisions of the Andhra Pradesh Public Employment (Regulation of Age of superannuation) (Amendment) Act'2014 (Act No.4/2014) orders were issued in the G.O. Ms.No.147, Finance (HRM IV) Department, Dt:30.06.2014 enhancing the age of superannuation from 58 years to 60 years to the State Government employees. In the G.O.Ms.No.112, Dt:18.06.2016 orders were issued that the enhanced age of superannuation cannot be made applicable to the employees of the Public Sector Undertakings and Institutions listed in the IX & X Schedules of AP Reorganization Act'2014 until the matter of division of assets and liabilities of the Institutions between the States of Andhra Pradesh and Telangana, is settled and the allotment of the employees between the two states is finalized for these Public Sector Undertakings / Institutions.

02). Aggrieved by the orders of the Government, certain employees working in the institutions listed in the IX & X schedule of the AP Re-organization Act'2014 have filed W.Ps in the Hon'ble High Court pleading for enhancement of age of superannuation to them on par with the Government employees. The Hon'ble High Court vide its judgement in W.P.Nos.18205 & others of 2014 and batch Dated 07.03.2017 while setting aside the orders issued by the Government, has passed the following orders.

“The earlier GOs were issued by the Govt. of AP without these legal entities amending its rules / regulations / bye-laws, governing the age of superannuation and without the prior approval of the sole / majority shareholder i.e. the State Govt. as required under the Articles of Association / bye-laws of these legal entities. As the rules & regulations, by which the petitioners are governed, stipulate 58 years as the age of retirement, these employees cannot claim any right to continue in service till they attain the age of 60 years. It is only if the request of these Companies / Corporations / Societies, for amendment of its bye-laws / rules & regulations, are approved by the State Govt. and the rules / bye-laws / regulations are amended thereafter in accordance with law, would their employees then be governed by the enhanced age of superannuation prescribed under the Rules / bye-laws.

Since, the Board of Directors / Managing Committees of these wholly or substantially government owned Companies / Corporations / Societies have submitted proposals, the State Government is obligated to consider the request of each of these Corporations / Companies / Societies separately, based on their financial position, genuineness of their need to enhance the age of superannuation etc., and then take a decision whether or not their request, to enhance the age of superannuation of their employees from 58 years to 60 years, should be approved. Suffice it, if the Govt. of AP is directed to consider the proposals submitted by each of these Corporations / Societies / Companies, for enhancement of the age of superannuation from 58 to 60 years in accordance with law and take a decision thereupon at the earliest, if any event not later than four months from the date of receipt of a copy of this orders.”

03). The Association for Andhra Pradesh Public Sector Undertakings in their representation dt:21.03.2017 has requested to extend the provisions of the G.O.Ms.No.147, Dt:30.06.2014 with effect from 02.06.2014 as per the judgement of the Hon'ble High Court in various Writ Petitions.

04). Government of Andhra Pradesh after careful examination of the matter accorded principle approval to enhance the age of superannuation of employees working in the institutions listed in IX & X of A.P. Re-organisation Act 2014, subject to certain conditions and orders laid down in G.O.Ms.No.102, Finance (HR.IV-FR) Dept. DT:27.06.2017.

05). After careful consideration, The Board of Directors of APGENCO, keeping in view of the orders issued vide G.O. 3rd and letter 4th cited, and has decided to enhance the age of superannuation of its employees from 58 years to 60 years with immediate effect.

06). Accordingly, the APGENCO is hereby issues order to enhance the age of superannuation from 58 years to 60 years (sixty) to the employees of APGENCO with immediate effect. Necessary amendment to the Service Regulations will be issued separately.

07). The Station heads & Functional heads at Head Quarters are requested to follow these orders scrupulously.
