**ORDER :**

In the Memorandum read above, a committee was constituted to study and recommend the names of the hospitals from the newly represented hospitals for empanelment, to accord recognition by the AP Genco to render treatment to its employees on credit basis.

2) Accordingly, the said Committee has visited the hospitals and submitted a detailed report for recognition of the said hospitals and for entering into credit tie-up with the said hospitals for availment of medical services by the employees of AP Genco.

3) After careful consideration, the MD/APGENCO, hereby grants recognition to the following two hospitals for a period of 2 years from the date of issue of this orders to the benefit of employees/ pensioners/ dependents of employees of AP Genco to avail medical treatment on credit basis as in-patients for chronic diseases/major operations etc.,. The credit cards shall be issued by the AP Genco from time to time on case to case basis only, in case the eligible persons one of the AP Genco employees/ pensioners/dependents are hospitalized for treatment. The name and address of the hospitals is as follows:-

- i) M/s. Sunshine Hospitals, 1-7-201 to 205, P.G.Road, Beside Paradise Hotel, Secunderabad – 500 003.
- ii) M/s. Star Hospitals, 8-2-596/5, Road No-10, Banjarahills, Hyderabad – 500 034.

3 (b) The recognition granted in para-3 above is subject to the condition that they shall charge the rates as per the CGHS tariff, and they shall offer 10% and 15% discount on Hospitals rates respectively.

The permission accorded in para (3) above is liable for cancellation and such other action as deemed fit, whenever the AP Genco forms the opinion that the said Private Hospital is not providing treatment to the AP Genco employees/retired employees and their dependents as stipulated after giving (15) days notice to the Hospital and pass appropriate orders, after considering the representation if any, offered by the said Hospital.
