ABSTRACT

Incentives - APGENCO - Srisailam Right Bank Power House - Restoration of submerged units into operation in record time - Sanction of Cash Incentive- Orders - Issued.

Ref: From the Chief Engineer/Projects, NoteDt25-2-2010.

Chief Engineer, Projects in his note dtd.25-2-2010 has stated that due to sudden and un precedent floods in River Krishna during the 1st week of October 2009, the inflows in to the Srisailam Reservoir reached to record level of 25 lakhs cusecs. The FRL of reservoir reached to 896' beyond its FRL 885' the discharges from the reservoir to the down stream of river was also maintained at the same level of 25 lakhs cusecs against the designed discharges of 19 lakhs cusecs . The tail race water level in the river has raised to 196.1 mts. The power house located in adjacent to the dam got submerged in water. All the equipment generators, control room, and Generator Transformers got inundated. The water gone up to the EOT crane rail level. The flood water gushed into the power house with high intensity, the power house walls, the D.T.deck and Gantry Crane washed out in flood water. The D.T gates located in the vents also got dislocated and got strucked up in the vents. The damage was not limited to SRBPH, the flood water enter into left bank power house, through tail race and the impact of water waves made the D.T. gates in the surge pool of SLBPH also got dislocated and deformed, and fallen in the surge pool tie beams at various elevations from 122 mts to 189 mts. The missing gates were located by carrying under water driving works, with specialized divers and specialized equipment and units were made available for generation in short period.

2) The tasks of restoration of power house and revamping of main equipment were taken up by APGENCO by awarding works to M/s. BHEL. The works were carried out by personnel deputed from various power plants of APGENCO and APTRANSCO. The works were carried out on war footing round the clock. The untiring efforts of the employees of both the power houses and personnel deputed from other power plants made task successful.

3) The service rendered by the employees for the restoration of the power house was more valuable and it is found expedient to encourage the employees and to keep their morale high up, the APGENCO has taken a decision to award incentive by way of monetary benefit to the employees who have participated in revamping of plant and equipment and restoration of Srisailam Right Bank Power House as a token of good will gesture.

4) Accordingly, after careful consideration, the APGENCO here by accords sanction for payment of cash Incentive to the staff who have attended the revamping works of Srisailam Right Bank Power House and SLBPH during 4-10-2009 to 20-1-2010, as follows:-

- (i) To all the regular staff on rolls of SRBPH : 30 days
- (ii) To all the regular staff on rolls of SLBPH : 15 days
- (iii) On TOUR/CAMP:
- (a) Less than 15 days : No incentive
- (b) 15 days to 30 days : 10 days

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- (c) Above 30 days less than 2 months : 20 days
(d) Above 2 months : 30 days
- 5) The payment of above incentive shall be subject to the following conditions:
- (i) For the purpose of payment of above incentive, the basic pay +DA as on 01-01-2010 shall be taken into consideration.
 - (ii) Those who have received any similar incentive in any other project during financial year 2009-2010 are not eligible for award of this incentive.
 - (iii) The period of their attendance shall be reckoned by CE/O&M/Srisailam based on their approved tour diaries etc., and issue of attendance certificate to the concerned Pay Drawing Officer for payment.
 - (iv) The payment of incentive shall be made by the respective Pay Drawing Officers duly obtaining certificate of attendance from CE/O&M/Srisailam.
- 6) This order issues with the concurrence of the Director (Finance) vide his U.O.No:22, Dt:7-4-2010.
