ORDER:

The Government of A.P have issued certain guidelines as interim measures for tentative placement of surplus employees of M/s. Hyderabad Allwyn Limited in various Departments/PSUs duly forming a Committee vide G.O.Rt.No.383, dtd.31.03.1993. The Government, redeployed 40 Technical/Non-Technical surplus employees to the erstwhile APSEB. It was also ordered that the salaries & allowances will be charge on the Government claimed by the drawing officer of the respective HODs duly utilizing them in suitable need based manner. Based on the recommendations of the Committee, the Government inter-alia, ordered in reference (2&9) cited that the redeployed employees of Ex-Allwyn are to be tentatively placed in Government Departments/Corporations in supernumerary posts. In pursuance of the decision, the erstwhile APSEB issued orders vide references (4&6) read above creating supernumerary posts of Junior Executives. In the references (5, 7 &11) read above, it was ordered to utilize Junior Executives having Engineering qualifications as A.Es and Junior Executive (non-Technical) as Assistant (now JPO). In the references (13 & 14) read above, orders were issued extending the scale of pay as admissible to the AE/PO of erstwhile APSEB to Junior Executives with effect from the date of their joining in the Board's service.

2. The APGENCO in the G.O.O.No.402/GM(A)/02, dtd.26.10.02 has issued orders absorbing the following 9 employees of M/s. HAL presently working in APGENCO as Junior Executives(Techl) as AEs (Mechl) with effect from the date of issue of these orders subject to review & finalization of the modalities by the Government of A.P:

In the references (16 & 17) read above, GOAP have issued orders regularizing the services of these employees working in Govt., Depts./PSUs from the date of their joining against the supernumerary posts and under any circumstances, they cannot be fitted into the seniority of regular servants and promotions considered.

4. In the reference (18 & 19) read above, the APGENCO has issued orders regularizing the services of employees of M/s. HAL referred above and Sri C. Trivikrama Raju with effect from 31.03.1993 or from the date of actual joining in the APSEB in the cadre of Junior Executives and as AEs(Mechl) w.e.f 26.10.02 & 14.11.02 respectively. It was also ordered therein to extend the pay applicable to the AE to the re-deployed employees of M/s.HAL who are presently working in APGENCO w.e.f their date of joining subject to results of W.A & W.Ps pending in the Hon'ble High Court of A.P in the subject matter.

5. The Government of A.P have issued orders vide G.O.Ms.No.77, dtd.26.02.09 for regularization of services of erstwhile M/s.Hyderabad Allwyn Limited re-deployed employees in to Government Departments by allowing seniority, considering the qualification, eligibility for holding the respective equivalent post/cadre in the departments on par with the regular Govt., servants from the date of deployment where they are presently positioned duly abolishing supernumerary posts. Further, the Hon'ble High Court of A.P in its orders dtd.01.05.09 directed to extend all the benefits mentioned in G.O.Ms.No.77, dtd.26.02.09 while disposing the W.A.No.1334/05, W.P.No.6120/03 & W.P.No.6127/03.

6. After careful consideration, the APGENCO hereby issues the following orders.

- (a) The services of 10 Junior Executives mentioned in paras 2 & 4 above shall be regularized against regular posts by allowing seniority etc., on par with regular employees.
- (b) Regularization shall be with effect from the date of their deployment to erstwhile APSEB duly treating as fresh entrants for the purpose of fixing seniority.
- (c) Now, the Junior Executives who are having B-Tech/B.E/AMIE (Mechanical), shall be considered against the regular post of Assistant Engineer(Mechl.) in the pay scale of Assistant Engineer.
- (d) In accordance with the above, appointment/posting orders to all the individuals will be issued separately against the existing vacancies.
- (e) Pay fixation shall be as per erstwhile APSEB/APGENCO Rules & Regulations issued from time to time. However, their pay shall be protected.
- (f) Fixation of seniority and issue of promotions will be examined separately keeping in view of the options process rules in vogue and G.O.Ms.No.77, dtd.26.02.09 duly giving show cause notice to those employees who are likely to be affected.
