APGENCO – Welfare Measures – Establishment of DAV English medium school for the first time at PJHES/Revulapally - Sanction – Accorded.

ORDER:

In the reference 1st cited, proposal was received from the Superintending Engineer (Civil)/JHES, Revulapally, to establish DAV Primary School to cater to the needs of employees working at PJHEP, Revulapally. In the reference 2nd cited, the Superintending Engineer/Civil Construction and O&M Circle, SLBHES, Camp PJHEP, Revulapally, has sent proposals to establish pre-primary school run by Viswa Bharathi High School, Gadwal, at PJHEP, Revulapally, based on the request made by the APSEB Engineers' Association and APSEB Assistant Engineers Association, PJHEP Branch. In the reference 3rd cited, the APGENCO has approached the Regional Director, DAV Institutions, South Zone, Hyderabad, to set up a School at PJHEP, Revulapally. In turn, the DAV Institutions have deputed their team of Officers to Jurala on 06.03.2010 to study and survey to explore the feasibility of establishing the school. In the reference 4th cited the Regional Director, DAV Institutions have submitted their survey/preliminary report and requested to send a letter to them to establish school at PJHEP, Revulapally with 100% deficit meeting clause and the school should grow up to X class,

which will enable them to take up the issue with their apex body DAV CMC, Delhi. In the reference 5th cited, the APGENCO has requested the DAV Institutions to take up the issue of establishment of English Medium school at PJHEP/Revulapally during the ensuing academic year 2010-2011 with their apex body, DAV CMC, Delhi. It was also requested therein to communicate the initial budget required for establishing the school indicating the approximate amount of expenditure on each of the components including the capital investment, and also deficit budget to run the school during the academic year of 2010-2011. In the reference last cited, the DAV Institutions have submitted Budget Estimates to a tune of Rs. 20.24 Lakhs for opening the school at PJHEP, Revulapally, in addition to capital expenditure, infrastructure, furniture & fixtures, computers, office equipment, library, labs and musical equipments.

2. The request of the Superintending Engineer (Civil)/JHES, Revulapally, to establish DAV Primary School and Superintending Engineer/Civil Construction and O&M Circle, SLBHES, Camp PJHEP, Revulapally, to establish a school run by Viswa Bharathi High School, Gadwal at PJHEP, Revulapally has been examined and taken decision to entrust the responsibility of establishing school to DAV Institutions, a reputed charitable trust.

3. After careful consideration, the Managing Director, APGENCO has accorded approval as follows:

- (i) To establish an English Medium DAV Public School at PJHEP, Revulapally, Upper Jurala from LKG to V class funded by APGENCO commencing from this academic year 2010-2011 and to enter into agreement with DAV Institutions to that effect and ;
- (ii) Provisional sanction of Rs. 20.00 Lakhs (Rupees twenty lakhs only) as Budget towards meeting the expenditure on Salaries, Establishment, Statutory Payments, TA/DA, Sports/Games, Printing/Stationery, Library books, Postage & Telephones etc as proposed by DAV Institutions which shall be as per actuals;
- (iii) Sanction of Rs. 3.00 Lakhs (Rupees three lakhs only) towards procurement of required School furniture as per the proposal submitted (ANNEXURE ENCLOSED);
- (iv) Sanction of Rs. 1.50 Lakhs (Rupees one lakh and fifty thousand only) towards xerox machine and public addressing system;
- (v) Sanction of Rs. 1.00 lakh (Rupees one lakh only) towards two computers and Printer for office use;

- (vi) Sanction of Rs. 1.00 lakh (Rupees one lakh only) towards purchase of five computers required to meet necessities of students; and
- (vii) Sanction of Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty thousand only) towards miscellaneous expenditure.

4. The Superintending Engineer, E&M/PJHEP, is requested to take action on providing suitable accommodation to establish school and residential accommodation to the teachers and also make necessary arrangements on procurement of various items mentioned at item (iii) to (vii)

5. This orders issues with the concurrence of the Director (Finance) vide his U.O.No. 218, dtd 11.06.2010.


