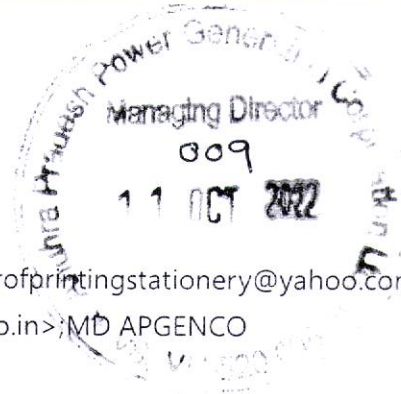

ORDER:

In the G.O 4th read above, the Government of Andhra Pradesh in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-sections (1) and (3) of section 3 of the Andhra Pradesh Essential Services Maintenance Act, 1971 (A.P. Act 20 of 1971), prohibited the strikes in all the services under the Transmission Corporation of Andhra Pradesh Ltd., three Distribution Companies (APEPDCL, APSPDCL & APCPDCL) and APGENCO in Andhra Pradesh for a period of six (6) months with effect from 10.05.2022 and the same will expire on 09.11.2022.

2. In the reference 5th read above, the Chairman & Managing Director, APTRANSCO has requested the Government to extend the orders of prohibiting the strikes in APTRANSCO and three (3) DISCOMs for a further period of 6 months with effect from 10.11.2022.

3. Accordingly, the following Notification will be published in an Extraordinary issue of Andhra Pradesh Gazette, dated 07th October, 2022:-
