Sub: APGENCO – Estt. –Enhancement of age of superannuation from 58 to 60 years, retrospectively w.e.f.02.06.2014-Reinduction of retired employees – Release of Commutation value of pension –Orders –Issued

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In the reference 1st cited, APGENCO issued orders duly enhancing the age of superannuation from 58 to 60years with effect from 02.06.2014.In the reference 2nd cited, Addendum to service regulations as contemplated in G.O.O.138,dt 08.08.2017 has been issued.

2. In the reference 3rd cited, the APGENCO have issued certain instructions to effect re-induction of retired employees consequent to issuance of G.O.O.s 1st &2nd cited.

3. Subsequently, the retired employees who have not attained the age of 60years, were served with notices informing them to remit back the pensionary benefits (Viz (a)Commutated value of pension(b)Retirement Gratuity and(c)Encashment of Earned leave along with interest up to the date of remittance on or before 30.09.2017 so as to issue of reinduction order. In response certain retired employees have remitted back the said pensionary benefits along with interest. Accordingly, orders have been reinducting them in to service.

4. In the ref 4th cited, certain re-inducted employees have represented that based on the notices served to them. they have remitted back the entire amount received by them towards commutation of pension along with interest to APGENCO till the date of remittance. But the commuted portion of pension to the extent of 40% was recovered from their monthly pension from the date of retirement till the date of remittance of lumpsum amount received towards commutation of pension. Hence they have requested to release the commuted portion of pension amount recovered from their monthly pension.

5. After careful consideration, APGENCO hereby accords permission to release the commuted portion of pension recovered from the monthly pension to the re-inducted employees who have remitted the pensionary benefits to APGENCO.

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6. These orders are issued with the concurrence of Managing Director in e-office dt.08.01.2018.
